AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCES 2020-17 AND 2020-20, WHICH AMENDED ORDINANCE 2020-07, 2020 PERMANENT APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Swanton, two-thirds (2/3) of the members elected thereto concurring and as follows:

Section One. That Ordinance 2020-07, including amendments in Ordinance 2020-17 and Ordinance 2020-20, 2020 Permanent Appropriation Ordinance, be amended to increase appropriations in the newly created Coronavirus Relief Fund, as a result of more funds received for expending monies during the 2020 appropriated year, as follows:

That this ordinance shall be declared an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public health, safety and welfare of the Village of Swanton; and for the further reason of the need to increase the appropriations for the remainder of the year to provide municipal services, wherefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effective immediately upon passage.
