

Ordinance 2021-07

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT FOR THE 2021 SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Swanton supported submission of an application to the Ohio Department of Transportation through the Safe Routes to School Program through Resolution 2018-03; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Swanton in conjunction with St. Richard Catholic School and Swanton Local School District applied for Safe Routes to School funding; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Swanton was successful in receiving State funding for said project; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Swanton deems this project in the best interest of public health, safety, and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Swanton has appropriated funds in the Capital Improvements Fund for said project; and

WHEREAS, the received bids on March 24, 2021 for the above referenced project from the following firms:

Smith Paving & Excavating	Bid	\$271,552. ⁴⁰	Alt. 1	\$36,000. ⁰⁰
RMH Concrete, Inc	Bid	\$281,574. ³⁶	Alt. 1	\$36,734. ⁴⁰

WHEREAS, The Village of Swanton's consulting engineer for the proposed 2021 Safe Routes to School Project, Poggemeyer Design Group, has evaluated the public bids opened for this project and recommends acceptance of the low bid submitted by Smith Paving & Excavating of Norwalk, Ohio

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Swanton, Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of the members elected thereto concurring and as follows:

Section One. That the Village Administrator is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with Smith Paving & Excavating of Norwalk, Ohio for 2021 Safe Routes to School Project for an amount not to exceed \$300,000 in accordance with the bid documents.

Section Two. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Village Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Village Council, and that all deliberations of this Village Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section Three. That this ordinance shall be declared an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public health, safety and welfare of the Village of Swanton and shall be in full force and effective immediately upon passage.


