

Ordinance 2018-07

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT FOR THE GARFIELD AVENUE BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Swanton submitted an application to Ohio Department of Transportation's Municipal Bridge Program for the replacement of the Garfield Avenue Bridge over Ai Creek; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Swanton will receive State and Federal funding for said project; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Swanton deems this project in the best interest of public health, safety, and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Swanton has appropriated funds in the Capital Improvements Fund for said project; and

WHEREAS, the received bids on March 16, 2018 for the above referenced project from the following firm:

WHEREAS, The Village of Swanton's consulting engineer for the proposed bridge replacement project design and bid, DGL Consulting Engineers, has evaluated the public bids opened for this project and recommends acceptance of the low bid submitted by Miller Bros Construction of Archobld, Ohio

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Swanton, Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of the members elected thereto concurring and as follows:

Section One. That the Village Administrator is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with Miller Bros. Construction, of Archbold, Ohio for bridge replacement for an amount not to exceed \$846,581.85 in accordance with the bid documents.

Section Two. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Village Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Village Council, and that all deliberations of this Village Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section Three. That this ordinance shall be declared an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public health, safety and welfare of the Village of Swanton and shall be in full force and effective immediately upon passage.
