A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING THE NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF LETTER CARRIERS 26TH ANNUAL STAMP OUT THE HUNGER FOOD DRIVE, MAY 12, 2018 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the National Association of Letter Carriers will be conducting their 26th Annual Stamp Out the Hunger Food Drive on Saturday, May 12, 2018; and

WHEREAS, this food drive is the largest one day food drive in the nation and all food collected stays in the community it is collected from; and

WHEREAS, in the Toledo area, over 400 letter carriers will be picking up food that day

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Swanton, Fulton County, Ohio, three-fourths of the members elected thereto concurring and as follows:

Section One: That the National Association of Letter Carriers is hereby recognized on their 26th Annual Stamp Out the Hunger Food Drive on Saturday, May 12, 2018 and wished much success in this important endeavor.

Section Two: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Village Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Village Council, and that all deliberations of this Village Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section Three: That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the village peace, health and safety; wherefore this resolution shall be in full force and effective immediately upon passage.




