

ORDINANCE 2018-16

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 52.01 (B) "WATER RATE STRUCTURE FOR ATHLETIC FIELDS LOCATED AT SWANTON HIGH SCHOOL" OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF SWANTON, OHIO.

WHEREAS, Section 52.01 (B) of the Codified Ordinances sets forth the water rate structure for the athletic fields located at Swanton High School in the Village of Swanton; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio and United States Environmental Protection Agencies continue to mandate rules and regulations governing the operation of public water systems which require the Village of Swanton to make improvements to its water plant and distribution system in order to comply with these state and federal rules and regulations; and

WHEREAS, in 2017, Village Council amended the water rate structure set forth in Section 52.01 (A).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by Council of the Village of Swanton, Fulton County, Ohio, that:

Section 1. That Section 52.01 (B) of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Swanton shall be amended to read as follows:

Water rate structure for athletic fields located at Swanton High School. Water rate structure for athletic fields located at Swanton High School serviced as sprinkler meter accounts only and not paying sanitary sewer charges shall be charged a monthly base rate of \$25.00 for 0-2,000 gallons used and \$6.04 per 1,000 gallons for 2,001 gallons and above. The usage rate per 1,000 gallons shall increase automatically as follows: \$0.17 increase per year effective January 1 of each subsequent year.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be effective at the earliest time allowed by law.


