Ordinance 2018-29

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR AND/OR VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL NON-INFRASTRUCTURE FUNDS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Safe, Accountable, Flexible, Efficient Transportation equity Act establishes the Safe Routes to School Program; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Swanton in conjunction with St. Richard Catholic School and Swanton Local School District applied for Safe Routes to School funding; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Swanton was granted \$13,411 in non-infrastructure funding; and

WHEREAS, for the reason that said agreement is immediately necessary in order for said project to be completed, this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare of said Village of Swanton; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by Council of the Village of Swanton, State of Ohio, members thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the Mayor, and/or Village Administrator, and hereby is, authorized and directed to enter the Safe Routes to Schools Program agreement for non-infrastructure funds a copy of which agreement is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

Section 2. That for the reason that the agreement is immediately necessary in order for said project to be proceed in a timely fashion and be properly funded, this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure, immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare of said Village of Swanton.

Section 3. That is Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage by Council and approval.
