## Ordinance 2018-31

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 2018-12 AUTHORIZING VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT FOR THE CHURCH STREET RECONSTRUCTION PHASE 1 PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Swanton submitted an application to the Ohio Public Works Commission for road reconstruction project on Church Street between Lincoln and Crestwood Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Swanton will receive State funding for said project; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Swanton deems this project in the best interest of public health, safety, and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Swanton has appropriated funds in the Capital Improvements Fund for said project; and

WHEREAS, the received bids on April 18, 2018 for the above referenced project from the following firm:

B&J Concrete and Construction

Base Bid

\$432,404.00

WHEREAS, The Village of Swanton's consulting engineer for the proposed road improvement project design and bid, Poggemeyer Design Group, has evaluated the public bids opened for this project and recommends acceptance of the low bid submitted by B&J Concrete and Construction of Toledo, Ohio.

WHEREAS, since the passage of Ordinance 2018-12 additional information about the project has led to the potential for increased costs in this project;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Swanton, Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of the members elected thereto concurring and as follows:

Section One. That Ordinance 2018-12 be amended as hereinafter set forth and that all provisions in conflict with said ordinance are hereby repealed and replaced with the provisions in this

ordinance. That the Village Administrator is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with B&J Concrete and Construction of Toledo, Ohio for road improvements for an amount not to exceed \$500,000.00 in accordance with the bid documents.

Section Two. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Village Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Village Council, and that all deliberations of this Village Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section Three. That this ordinance shall be declared an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public health, safety and welfare of the Village of Swanton and shall be in full force and effective immediately upon passage.
