Restrictions:

Limit of two pickup, trailer or equal loads of trash
No leaves, grass clippings, brush, or tree limbs
No tires, motor oil, vehicle bodies or engines.
No rocks, bricks, concrete, asphalt, or construction materials.
No enclosed drums or tanks, all containers must be empty with lids removed.

No chemicals, oil, gas, ammunition, explosives, hazardous or toxic chemicals.

No refrigerators, air conditioners or any appliances containing Freon. No televisions

*Individuals will pay a per can cash fee. Quarts-\$1.00, Gallons-\$2.00, and 5 Gallons \$6.00
