- 1. Bulk/Large Item Collection Service
 - a. Republic will suspend the collection of bulk/large items in the Village of Swanton
 - b. Republic is asking residents with these items to hold off on placing these items out for collection until Republic resumes the collection of these items
- 2. Bag It Before You Trash It
 - a. Republic is asking residents to please bag their trash prior to placing their trash into their trash can or cart. This will prevent loose debris from blowing out of the truck during collection. In addition, this will reduce exposure to items of potential concern.
- 3. Trash weights and volumes
 - a. With everyone staying home, Republic is seeing an increase in the volume of materials placed out for collection
 - b. Republic will continue to provide collection service although collection may run a little slower than normal as a result of the increased volumes and weights
- 4. Recycling Collection
 - a. Recycling is not impacted at this time
 - b. Republic will continue to monitor recycling materials for possible increased contamination
