

RESOLUTION 2020-17

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF BENFIELD WINES LIQUOR PERMIT TEMPORARY EXPANSION REQUEST DURING THE STATE OF EMERGENCY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Governor DeWine declared a State of Emergency due to the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Commerce released instructions on temporary liquor permit premises expansion requests; and

WHEREAS, Rob & Julia Benfield own Benfield Wines located in the Village of Swanton; and

WHEREAS, Rob & Julia Benfield are request a Standard Temporary Expansion Request for Benfield Wines; and

WHEREAS, the proposed expansion area is under exclusive control of the Village of Swanton; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Swanton, Fulton and Lucas Counties, Ohio, all members elected thereto concurring and as follows:

Section One. The Council of the Village of Swanton is in support and approves the Standard Temporary Expansion Request as illustrated in Exhibit A.

Section Two. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section Three. That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the village peace, health and safety; wherefore this resolution shall be in full force and effective immediately upon passage.



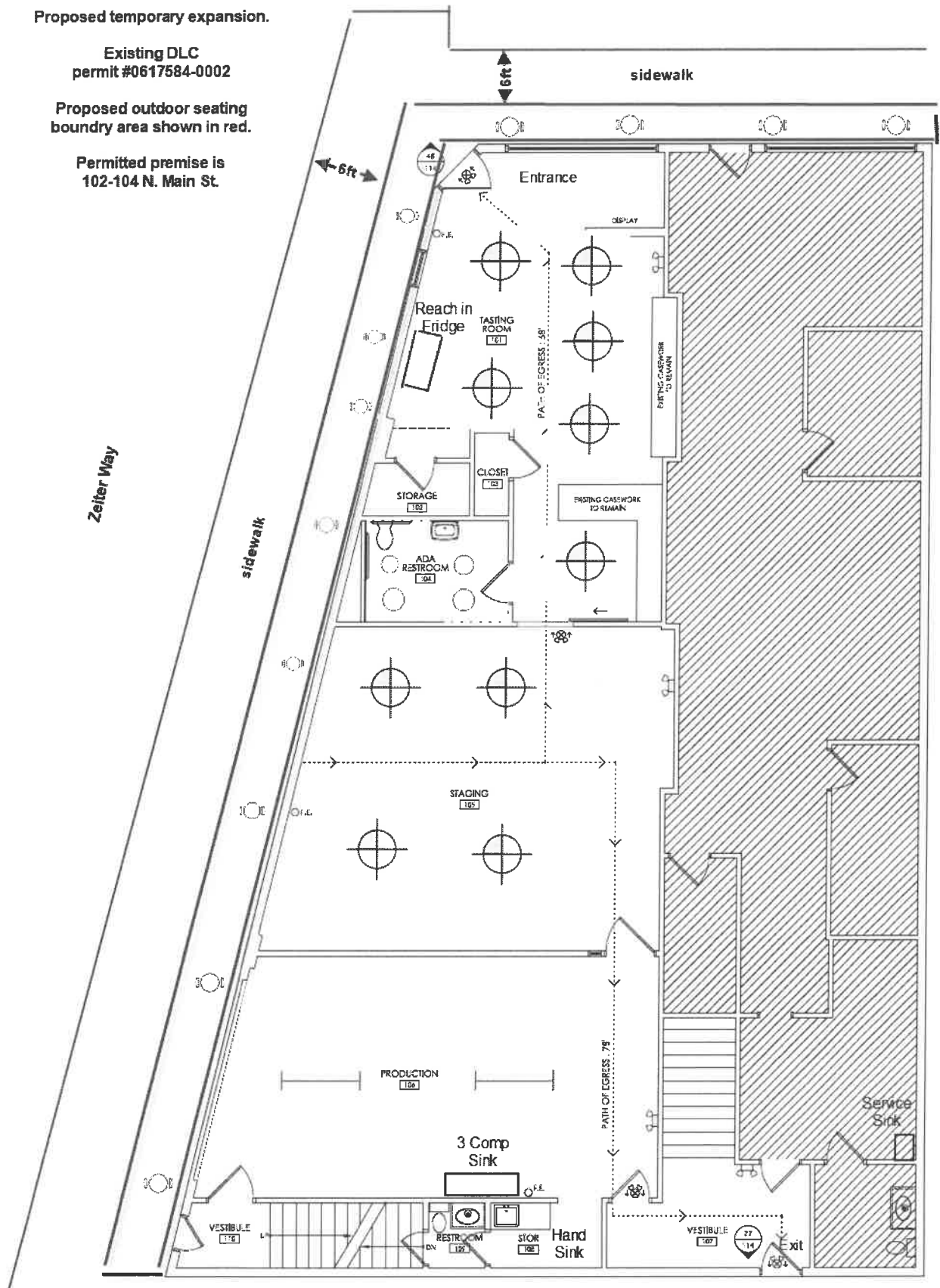
