Ordinance 2020-27

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO RENEW THE AGREEMENT FOR A COUNTYWIDE EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY

WHEREAS, by Resolution 2012 – 6 adopted on May 14, 2006, the Council of the Village of Swanton authorized the establishment and participation in the Fulton County Emergency Management Agency as provided by Section 5502 of the Ohio Revised Code; and

WHEREAS, the Fulton County Emergency Management Agency asks each participating political subdivision within the County to annually renew the agreement to promote awareness of the agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Swanton, Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of the members elected thereto concurring and as follows:

Section One. That the Village Administrator is hereby authorized and empowered to execute the renewal the Fulton County Emergency Management Agency for <u>2021</u> under Section 5502 of the Ohio Revised Code

Section Two. That the Village of Swanton is authorized to participate in the Fulton County Emergency Management Agency as a member of the executive committee

Section Three. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Village Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Village Council, and that all deliberations of this Village Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section Four. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest date allowed by law.
