Ordinance 2021-01

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT FOR THE BEARD PAVILION REPLACEMENT PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the original Beard Pavilion was damaged in a wind storm; and

WHEREAS, the damage to Beard Pavilion caused for complete demolition of said structure; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Swanton will receive insurance funding for said project; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Swanton deems this project in the best interest of public health, safety, and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the received bids on January 13, 2021 for the above referenced project from the following firms:

WHEREAS, The Village Administrator has evaluated the public bids opened for this project and recommends acceptance of the low bid submitted by Rupp/Rosebrock, Inc. of Liberty Center, Ohio.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Swanton, Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of the members elected thereto concurring and as follows:

Section One. That the Village Administrator is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with <u>Rupp/Rosebrock</u>, <u>Inc. of Liberty Center</u>, <u>Ohio</u> for <u>Beard Pavilion Replacement</u> for an amount not to exceed <u>\$75,000</u> in accordance with the bid documents.

Section Two. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Village Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Village Council, and that all deliberations of this Village Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section Three. That this ordinance shall be declared an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public health, safety and welfare of the Village of Swanton and shall be in full force and effective immediately upon passage.
