## Resolution 2021-17

## AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF DEVELOPMENT (ODOD) WATER AND WASTEWATER INFRASTRUCTURE GRANT PROGRAM AND TO ENTER INTO ANY AGREEMENTS AS REQUIRED

WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Development will provide nearly \$250 million in grant funding to make necessary investments in water and wastewater infrastructure and;

WHEREAS, the Village of Swanton is planning to construct improvements to the Village water and wastewater plants and systems, and;

WHEREAS, the infrastructure improvements herein above described are considered to be a priority need for the community and are qualified projects under the ODOD program.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Swanton, Fulton County, Ohio, three-fourths of the members elected thereto concurring and as follows:

Section One. The Village Administrator is hereby authorized to apply to the ODOD for funds as described above.

Section Two. The Village Administrator is further authorized to enter into any agreements as may be necessary and appropriate for obtaining this financial assistance.

Section Three. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Village Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Village Council, and that all deliberations of this Village Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section Four. That this resolution shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest date allowed by law.
