BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Swanton, two-thirds (2/3) of the members elected thereto concurring and as follows:

Section One. That Ordinance 2021-06, 2021 Permanent Appropriation Ordinance, be amended to increase appropriations in the newly created Local Fiscal Recovery Fund, as a result of funds received through the American Rescue Plan Act, as well as an amendment to increase appropriations in Fund 2053 for expending monies during the 2021 appropriated year, as follows:
