Memorial Park Structures ADA Accessibility and Inclusivity

Majority of the playground area

- Poured in Place Rubber Surfacing
 - Highly accessible for mobility devices
 - Increased safety in case of falls
 - ADA approved surface

Phase 2 Area (geared towards 2-4 year olds)

- Sensory Wave Seat (3205)
 - Side handles offer transfer assistance and support while spinning
 - Front pommel design helps maintain a neutral body position while spinning
 - ADA accessible
- Flower Spinner Panel (19832)
 - Sensory play that enhances fine and gross motor skills
 - ADA accessible
 - Ground level to allow easy access

Phase 1 Area (Swings)

- Expression Swing Tandem (5167)
 - Face to face to encourage social interaction
 - Inclusive
 - Ground level for increased access
- Expression Swing (5128)
 - Promotes social interaction and processing sensory information
 - Inclusive

- Ground level for increased access
- Enclosed Tot Seat Package (1470)
 - Increases spatial awareness and helps develop gross and fine motor skills
 - ADA accessible
 - Ground level for increased access
- Expression Swing with Adaptive Seat (5165)
 - Adaptive seat provides additional support for children of all abilities
 - Provides opportunities for multigenerational play
 - ADA accessible
 - Ground level for increased access
- ADA Primetime Swing (12583)
 - ADA compliant and specifically designed for wheelchair users
 - Ground level for increased access

Phase 1 Area (Main Structure; geared towards 5-12 year olds)

- Roxall See Saw (6245)
 - High backs and side rails on all seats are designed to accommodate users of all abilities
 - Center saucer is designed for users to transfer easily from a mobility device
 - ADA accessible
 - Inclusive for up to 5 users
- Hand Cyclus (81669)
 - Fidget toy that spins
 - ADA and inclusive
 - Ground level for accessible fun
 - Large, easy to grip handles
 - Attached to the larger play structure to promote inclusivity
- Seat and Table for Two (81665)
 - Ground level with PIP surface for easy mobility access
 - Attached to the main structure to promote inclusiveness
 - A sit down location for children of various abilities to spend time together
