All benches will be uniform and adoption of the bench will be acknowledged by an engraved plaque.

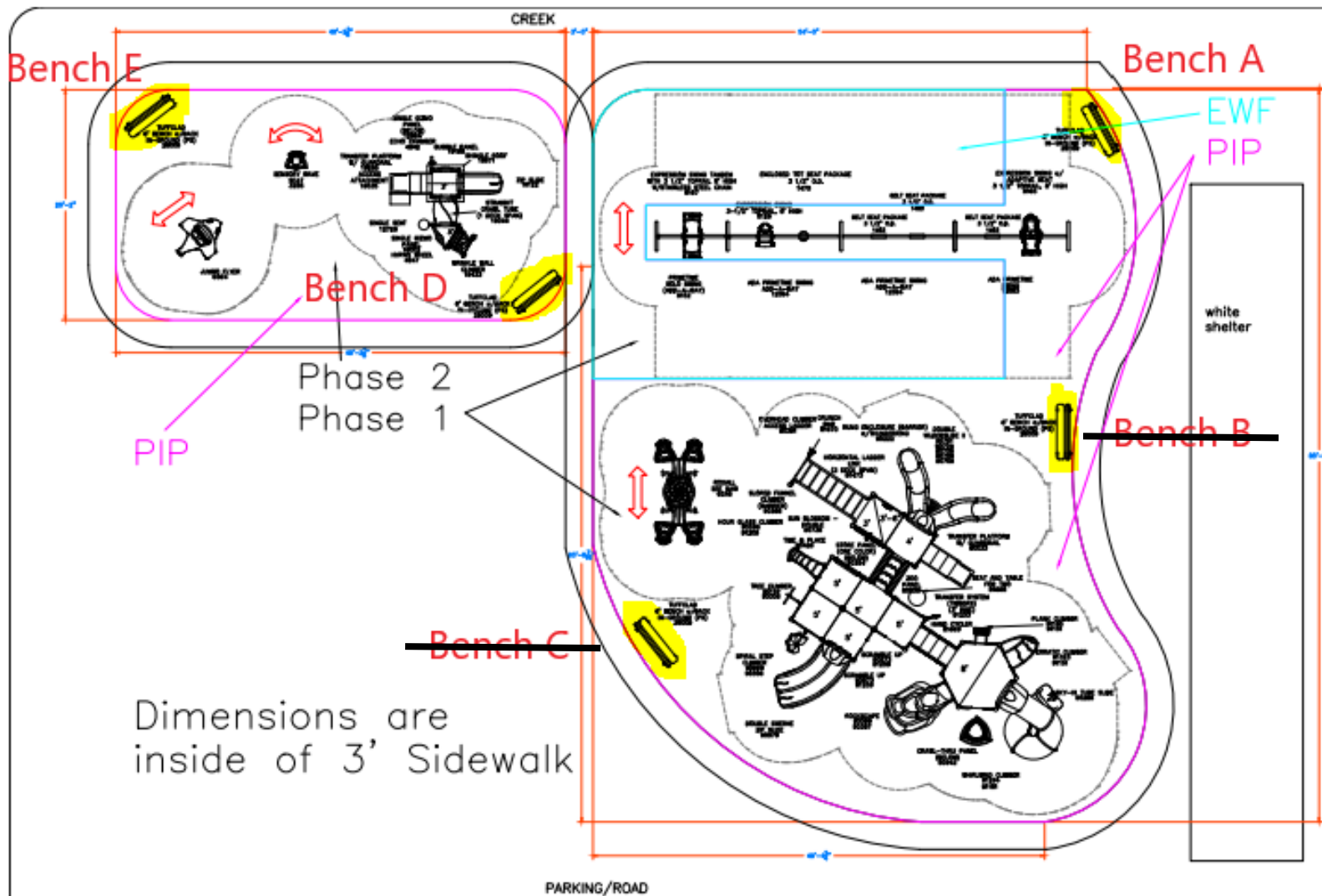
Bench availability is limited- you won't want to miss out on this opportunity! First come, first serve basis.



Please allow up to 8 weeks after order is placed for plaque to arrive. Upon receipt of plaque, the Village of Swanton requires minimum two weeks to schedule installation.

The maintenance of the benches will be the responsibility of the Public Service Division and will be provided by the for the life of the bench.

There is a ten-year (10) guarantee of furniture maintenance and plaque replacement. The furniture will be kept in place as long as it is serviceable beyond the 10 year period. When a bench is no longer serviceable, applicants will be advised and given the opportunity to purchase a new bench under the terms and conditions then in effect.
