A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ENTERING INTO AN AGREEMENT

WITH MANGNEGRIP FOR THE EXHAUST VENTILATION SYSTEM AT

THE SWANTON FIRE & RESCUE DEPARTMENT, AND DECLARING

AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village of Swanton has received a proposal from MagneGrip known as

"Alternative Bid #1" for the installation of an exhaust ventilation system in the Swanton Fire

Department.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Swanton, Fulton

County, Ohio, three-fourths of the members elected thereto concurring and as follows:

Section 1. That Council hereby approves and authorizes the Village Administrator to enter

into an agreement with MagneGrip for installation of an exhaust ventilation system in the Swanton

Fire Department pursuant to "Alternative Bid #1" in the amount of Sixty-eight Thousand Six Hundred

Thirty-five Dollars (\$68,635), of which, Sixty-one Thousand Nine Hundred Four Dollars (\$61,904)

shall be paid via grant funding, and the balance paid out of Village funds.

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of Council concerning or relating

to the passage of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Council, and that all

deliberations of this Council and any of its committees, that resulted in such formal actions, were in

meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the Village of Swanton and

the State of Ohio.

Section 3. This Resolution is deemed an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate

preservation of the public health, safety and welfare, and for the further reason that it is necessary to

have the exhaust ventilation system installed as soon as possible.
