the Bid, subject to conditions provided in the Instructions to Bidders. The successful bidder will be required to furnish satisfactory Performance Bond and Maintenance and Guarantee Bond in the amount of 100% of the Bid. The Contractor shall be required to pay not less than the pre-

vailing wage rates established by the Federal Davis Bacon rates issued by the U.S. Department of Labor. Domestic steel requirements, as specified in the American

Iron and Steel (AIS) requirements, a copy of the requirements is included in the Specifications. This project is subject to EPA Policy of Encouraging the Par-
