A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION AND SUPPORT OF AN APPLICATION TO THE GARY SINISE FOUNDATION FIRST RESPONDERS OUTREACH GRANT FUNDING

WHEREAS, the Gary Sinise Foundation administers Grant Funding and the Village of Swanton desires to seek funding assistance through the Gary Sinise Foundation for assistance in First Responder equipment in the Village of Swanton, Fulton County, Ohio.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Swanton, Fulton County, Ohio, three-fourths of the members elected thereto concurring and as follows:

Section One. That the Council of the Village of Swanton approves filing an application for financial grant assistance through the Gary Sinise Foundation and, if funded, entering into the required grant Agreements.

Section Two. The Village Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to execute and file an application with Gary Sinise Foundation and to provide all information and documentation required to become eligible for funding assistance to execute any and all other documents necessary to effectuate this designation.

Section Three. That this Council understands that there is no requirement for matching funding for this grant.

Section Four. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Village Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Village Council, and that all deliberations of this Village Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section Five: This resolution shall be in full force and effective immediately upon passage.
