A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION AND SUPPORT OF AN APPLICATION TO STAFFING FOR ADEQUATE FIREFIGHTER AND EMERGENCY RESPONSE (S.A.F.E.R) PROGRAM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) administers the S.A.F.E.R Program; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Swanton desires to apply for grant funding for Swanton Fire and Rescue through Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) S.A.F.E.R Program.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Swanton, Fulton County, Ohio, three-fourths of the members elected thereto concurring and as follows:

Section One. That the Council of the Village of Swanton approves filing an application through the S.A.F.E.R Program and, if funded, entering into the required agreements.

Section Two. The Fire Chief is hereby authorized and directed to execute and file an application with the S.A.F.E.R Program and to provide all information and documentation required execute any and all other documents necessary to effectuate this designation.

Section Three. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Village Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Village Council, and that all deliberations of this Village Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section Five: That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the village peace, health and safety; wherefore this resolution shall be in full force and effective immediately upon passage.
