- Current Ohio Department of Public Safety certificates: Firefighter II, Paramedic, Fire Safety Inspector, and Fire and/or EMS Instructor, including Live Fire Instructor.
- Hazardous Materials Operations certification.
- Currently hold Fire Officer I & II with the ability to obtain Fire Officer III & IV as required
- Hold NIMS ICS 100, 200, 300, 400, 700, and 800 certifications.
- A valid State of Ohio driver's license.

- Graduation from an accredited university in fire administration, public administration, or related field
- Haz-mat/WMD Technician Certification
- Knowledge of government accounting and budget preparation
- Prior experience leading a fire and rescue division in a professional manner

- Prior experience in database management
